Young Life Australia Camp Registration Terms and Conditions

Consent to medical attention: I confirm my consent to the activities my child will engage in while on a Young Life Australia camp and understand these activities carry the normal risks associated with them. I acknowledge the staff and volunteer agents of Young Life Australia will take all possible care but cannot be held responsible for unforeseen accidents or illness arising. I hereby consent to all medical, hospital, rescue procedures being employed in the best interests of my child and that I shall be notified as soon as possible should the continuance of such procedures be necessary.

Disclaimer: In the unforeseen event of personal injury or illness sustained while on a Young Life Australia camp, or the loss of personal property except where such property was held in the custody of Young Life Australia staff or volunteer agents when lost while on a Young Life Australia camp, I hereby release, and exempt, and indemnify the organisers, sponsors, and all other persons involved in the organisation of the Young Life Australia camp, from all action, proceedings, demands, costs, expense, and claims whatsoever made or taken by any person arising out of my child's participation in such camp, trip, or excursion.

Discipline: If in the event your child's behaviour is deemed by the organisers to be inappropriate or compromises the safety and or health of other participants on the camp, trip or excursion, then Young Life Australia reserves the right to send your child home, at the earliest possible time, by the most effective mode of transport in conjunction with your cooperation. This will be at your expense.

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$60.00 is required to hold your place on Young Life Australia's camp program. In order to secure the discounted rate, this deposit needs to be paid on or before the advertised early bird payment date.

Payment Policy: Full camp payment is required two weeks before camp commences. Failure to make full payment before camp commences may forfeit your / your child's place on camp.

Refund Policy:

Medication at camp: If your child requires prescription medication, they should bring enough medication for the duration of their stay. All medication should be in its original packaging and clearly labelled with your child's name, the dosage and frequency. You need to notify the camp organisers of all prescribed medications your child is taking.

Asthma and anaphylaxis: If your child suffers from asthma or anaphylaxis, they should have an asthma management plan or anaphylaxis action plan which has been prepared by their doctor. Download sample plan templates from <u>Australasian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy website</u> (link is external). If your child has a plan, please provide it to Young Life Australia staff prior to attending camp.

Children with asthma need to bring their own peak flow meters to camp and carry their inhaler with them at all times. Children at risk of anaphylaxis need to bring at least one adrenaline auto injector as Young Life Australia does not provide them.

Mobile phones and other electronic devices: Upon arrival at camp Young Life Australia collects all mobile phones and electronic devices to be stored in a secure environment for safe keeping. Young Life Australia takes no responsibility for the loss or damage to a client's personal property, including money or other valuable items. Failure to deposit these devices to camp staff and volunteers upon arrival at camp is deemed to be an issue of discipline.

We do not encourage campers to contact home as this can contribute to homesickness.

The camp director's phone number will be provided to you so that in an emergency you can contact camp staff and they can place you in contact with your child.
