

Young Life College - Residential Mentors

Young Life Australia is a non-denominational Christian charity that mentors and offers stable and caring role models to teenagers and operates in over a fifteen urban and rural communities around Australia. Our focus is to build confidence, values and resilience in Australia's young people through significant relationships with adults who model the love of Jesus Christ.

Young Life Australia has established a training facility in Armidale NSW and two positions have become available for Residential Mentors at the College. The positions are for one male and one female mentor to live on-site at the College and to mentor trainees & leaders also living on-site. The role aims to create a culture, which is both Christ and ministry focused and to ensure the smooth daily running of the household.

This role may be fulfilled by two separate individuals or a married couple.

The position requires individuals or couples who are well-organized, hospitable, have a pastoral outlook and are able to mentor and teach young adults.

The mentors would be accountable to the Young Life Australia National Office and management Committees.

To be successful in the role you will need to have a strong Christian faith, a mature outlook, a strong and established marriage (for couples), be suitably qualified, and agree with the aims and working principles of Young Life. Training in Young Life Australia's 'Leadership Foundations' will be provided.

Applications close on Friday 2nd Feb 2018 at 5pm and interviews will be conducted the 5th & 8th February 2018. Only short-listed candidates will be contacted. Desired start date is 12th February 2018.

Email a letter of application addressing the required and desired skills and also attach a resume for all applicants. You must be over 25, a permanent resident, and must pass a NSW 'working with children' as well as a national Police background check.
