



Young Life Field Staff Position Uralla – 1-2 days a week

A position has become available with Young Life Australia in Uralla, for 1 to 2 days a week, engaging with young people in the community whilst working closely with St John's Anglican Parish (Uralla).

Young Life Australia is a non-denominational Christian organisation that mentors and offers committed and caring role models to teenagers, operating in fifteen urban and rural communities around Australia. Our focus is to build confidence, values and resilience in Australia's young people through significant relationships with adults who model the love of Jesus Christ.

Young Life has a dynamic and unique ministry model based on a relational approach to young people both inside and outside the local church. Young Life is seeking a spiritually mature person with a heart for out-reach and discipleship to carry on the already established work with youth in Uralla. The role would be supervised by the Young Life New England Regional Manager, and supported by the local Young Life Uralla Area Committee.

To be successful in the role you will need to be a servant leader of high character, with a desire to build caring relationships with young people and share your faith. You must be confident in working with teenagers and a team of adult leaders, have a strong Christian faith and a mature outlook and agree with the aims and working principles of Young Life.

Depending on the experience of the applicant the role may be undertaken as a Field Staff or Area Coordinator position. Training in Young Life Australia's Leadership Foundations will be provided.

Applications close on Friday 19 July 2019 at 5pm and interviews will be conducted the following week. Only short listed candidates will be contacted. Desired start date is 1 August 2019.

- Empathy and experience in relating well with male and female youth
- Ability to lead others with a servant heart
- Sound organisational and time management skills
- The ability to show initiative and work well in a team environment

- Willingness to undertake regular Young Life Foundations Training
- Current unrestricted driver's licence

- Qualification and/or experience in youth work, theology or ministry (Cert IV or higher)
- Background in youth-related not-for-profit Christian organisation or Church Youth Ministry
