- Experience in working with primary and or high school aged young people.
- Sound spoken and written communication skills.
- High organisational and time management proficiencies.
- Ability to work both independently and in a team environment.
- Ability to lead a team of volunteers and delegate responsibility.
- Capacity to run and co-ordinate events.
- Current unrestricted driver licence.

HIGHLY DESIRABLE

- Additional training and/or experience in children's work, counselling, teaching, or theology (Diploma or higher).
- Experience in dealing with or counselling at-risk/disadvantaged young people.
- Experience in conflict resolution.
- Experience running children's programmes and activities.
- Background in youth/children's ministry.
