A part-time 2 day a week position is available in Bathurst for a dynamic and enthusiastic Area Manager with a 'can do' attitude, reporting to the National Executive team, and liaising with the Bathurst volunteer committee.

The person we seek must have a strong Christian faith, be self-motivated, confident contacting churches and building networks within the community and local government and driven to make a lasting difference in the lives of teens. Your understanding of teenagers, willingness to achieve set goals, and the ability to inspire, lead, and grow a team of volunteers, are important attributes needed to succeed in the role.

You will be responsible for managing Young Life's in school and out of school activities, delivering Young Life club and camping activities, implementing fundraising and donor care initiatives. There is an expectation the successful applicant will immediately conduct fundraising in order to ensure sustainability moving forward.

Training in Young Life's 'Leadership Foundations' will also be provided. Relevant background, police, and reference checks will be completed prior to the preferred candidate's employment being confirmed. Remuneration will be dependent on expertise and experience and discussed at interview.
